

## CAN PEOPLE BYO LIQUOR INTO YOUR CLUB?

**YES but only with the approval of the Club and only with a meal.**

- People, including Members, cannot bring unopened liquor (BYO) into your venue without the Club's approval.
- A Club committee can decide to allow BYO, remembering it can only be permitted when a meal is provided. (Meals can be tapas, share plates etc but not bags of chips.)
- Partly consumed bottles of liquor that are brought onto the premises can be taken away provided that they are in their original bottle and are sealed. The only exception to this rule is if the patron is leaving the Club and entering a "dry zone".
- Your Club can charge the patron corkage for opening the BYO.
- Good practices of Responsible Service of Alcohol still apply.
