

DO YOU KNOW HOW TO CONTACT SAPOL?

You may think it best to ring your local police station in an emergency. This would put you in touch with your nearest on duty officers, right?

Not anymore.

SAPol has established a 24/7 centralised communications centre in Adelaide CBS. This hub means they have eyes and ears on every mobile unit in the State and can deploy the nearest and most suitable vehicle to respond to your situation regardless of district boundaries.

There are just 3 numbers you need to know:

Triple Zero for emergencies and you will be asked which of Police, Fire and Ambulance you require

131 444

When you require non urgent police assistance

1800 333 000

Crime Stoppers to report crime

Think first then dial

	131 444 Police Assistance Line for non-urgent police assistance
	1800 333 000 Crime Stoppers report crime anonymously

HANDY TIP - LAND LINES

In recent times, there have been a couple of hold ups at businesses in South Australia. Hopefully, you will never need this next tip, but it's a good one to let staff know about where you have a landline behind a bar for instance.

There may be an occasion where you cannot actually pick up the phone to call however, **by knocking off the handset and dialing triple zero, the number appears at the police communications centre along with the physical address of that number.** This enables the dispatch centre to send the nearest vehicle to respond to the situation as well as listen to any sound.
