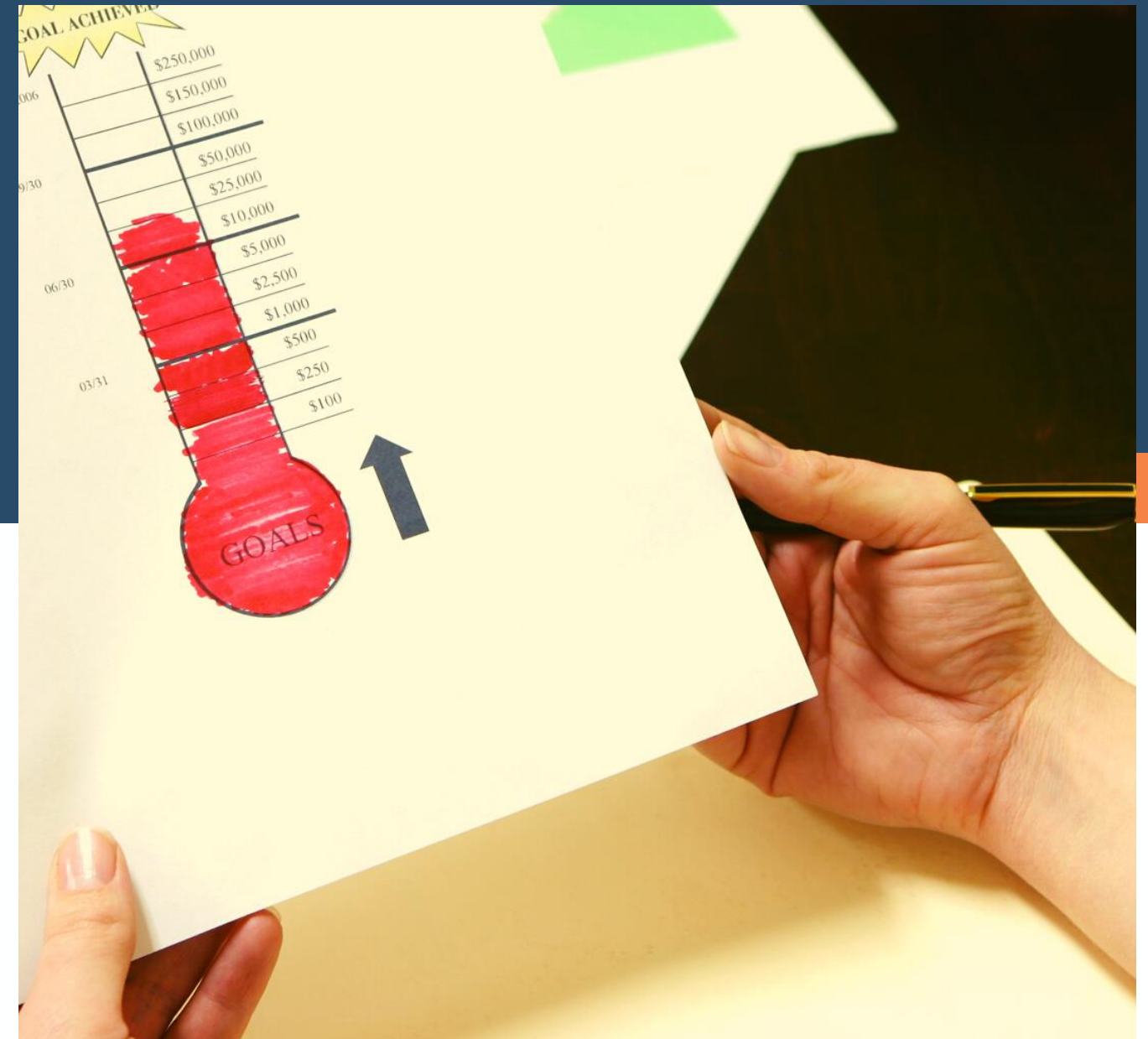

# MINOR FUNDRAISING LOTTERIES

- Prizes can't exceed \$5,000
- No licence required
- T & C's required
- At least 20% of gross proceeds must now go to the approved purpose.
- At least 20% must go back in prizes.





# INSTANT LOTTERIES

- Instant scratch or 'break-open' tickets
- Prizes can't exceed \$5,000
- Online annual licence required
- Tickets must be purchased from a licensed supplier
- **At least 20% of the gross proceeds must go back to the approved purpose.**
- At least 20% must go back in prizes
- Tickets must not be sold to under 18s
- **Renewals are completed online**
- **An auditor is no longer required to certify the financial statement**



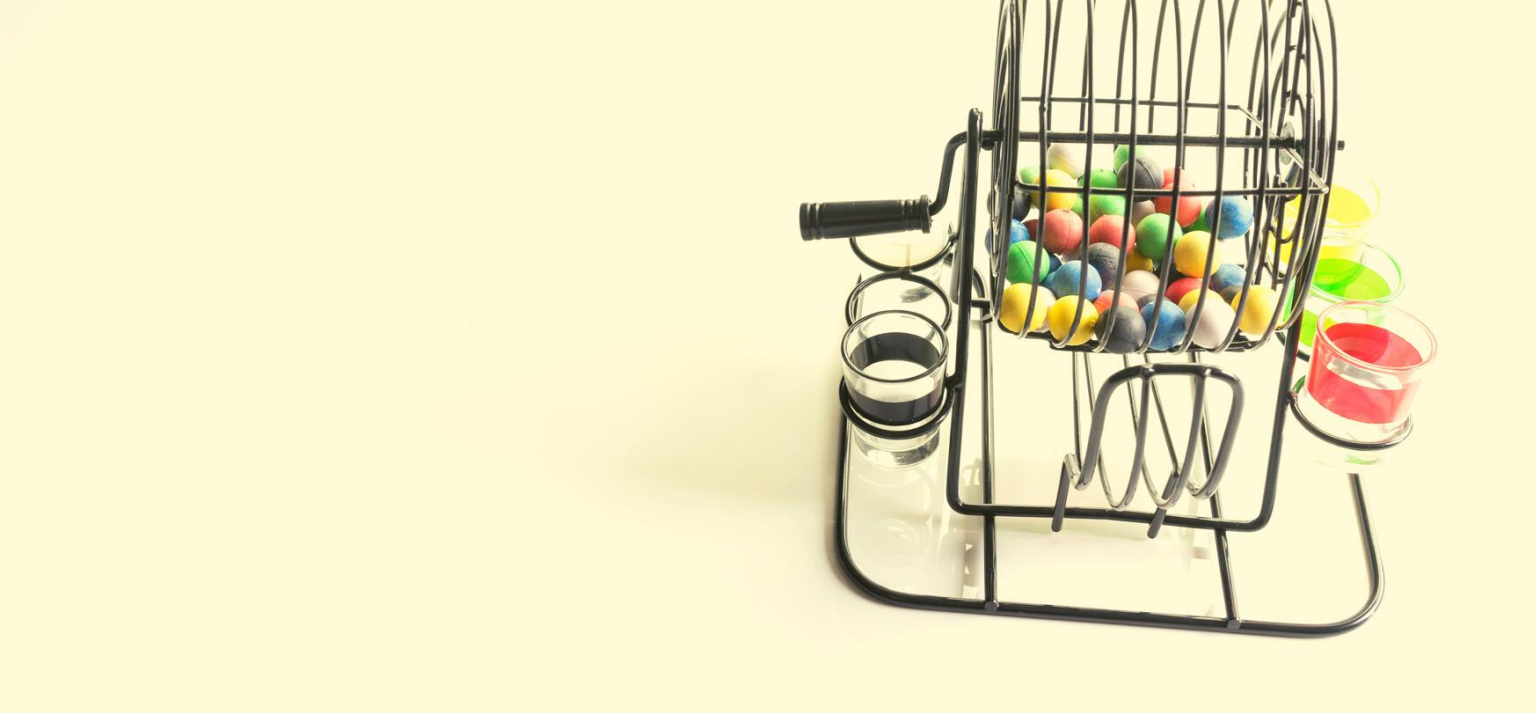
# PARTICIPATION LOTTERIES (MEMBERS DRAWS)

- Can only be held in clubs for club members
- No cost to members to enter
- Jackpotting up to \$5,000. Prizes can't exceed \$5,000
- T's & C's required. Can require the winner to be present at the draw
- **Another draw can take place 15 minutes or more from the last draw**



# MINOR BINGO

- No licence needed if the gross proceeds are \$1,000 or less per session.
- Number of sessions per week increased from 3 to 5
- At least 15% of gross proceeds must go back to an approved purpose
- Total prize value for each game must be at least 20% of gross proceeds
- Bingo cards must be purchased from a licensed supplier
- Players must be at least 18 years old unless accompanied by an adult.
- Any winner of more than \$100 must be recorded



# MAJOR BINGO



- Licence required
- Gross proceeds now more than \$1,000 per session
- Number of sessions per week increased from 3 to 5
- At least 20% of gross proceeds must be for an approved purpose
- Gross proceeds from each session increased from \$9,000 to \$10,000.
- Any winner of more than \$100 must be recorded.



# MINOR TRADE PROMOTION LOTTERIES

- Purchase a good or service and are given an instant scratch or 'break-open' ticket where the number, letter or symbol is hidden
- Prizes can't exceed \$5,000
- A licence from CBS is needed regardless of the total prize value
- Prizes drawn electronically no longer need approval for the drawing system
- Trade promotions consisting of bingo sessions in a gaming club are now permitted



# CARD JACKPOTS LOTTERIES

## (FLIP THE JOKER / CHASE THE ACE)



- Person whose ticket is drawn selects a card from a secure display board
- Gross proceeds for **each** draw can't exceed \$500
- The jackpot prize can't exceed \$5,000, however it can jackpot
- 20% of the gross proceeds must go to the approved purpose
- Under 18, committee members or employees are prohibited from participating
- The cards must be safely secured at all times
- No more than 2 members of the committee can have access to the board
- A winner of a draw must be given no less than 15 minutes to select a card

# SUMMARY

- Minor lotteries don't require a licence except if they have Instant Prizes
- All %s have been increased for the approved purposes
- Lotteries can't be jackpotted except for a Participation Lotteries or Card Jackpot lotteries
- T&Cs must be made available for each lottery, however they don't need to be formally lodged or approved
- **Prizes greater than \$1,000 must now be offered via EFT or cheque**
- **Committee members or anyone involved in the conduct or promotion of major fundraising, major bingo, trade promotion lotteries or card jackpot lotteries cannot participate in those lotteries**
- **Expiation fines have now been introduced**

# FAQ'S

- Alcohol can be given away as prizes and removed from the premises
- Under 16s can't sell lottery tickets unless accompanied by an adult
- Minors can enter lotteries unless the prizes are prohibited items
